INTRODUCTION

Our Club was formed in 1969 to cater for those owners of purebred dogs who were interested in trailing their dogs to Obedience Trial standard and has been very successful in this regard. On being granted affiliation with the Victorian Canine Association in 1979, all breeds whether registered or not have been accepted.

CLUB RULES

- All dogs should be kept on leash at all times, excepted when given permission to work off leash in class.
- Handlers wishing to leave their dogs tied up on the Club grounds should only do so if their dogs are safe with people especially children. No dog may be tied up where it can reach another dog.
- Dogs in season should not come down to training for four weeks. This does not mean you should stop the training of your dog.
- Dogs must be immunised against distemper and canine hepatitis before coming to classes. This should also be renewed yearly.
- A dog suffering from any illness or skin problems should not be brought to classes until a Vet has pronounced the condition not contagious.
- Handler must remove their dog's excreta from the training area implements are provided.
- Physical punishment of dogs is not permitted in training classes.
- Instructors have authority over their classes and may ask a member to take their dog out of class if it is disruptive.
- Instructors are not permitted to handle and train a member's dog in class.

- While at the grounds before and after classes please control your dogs, also hitting of other peoples dogs is not allowed.
- If Committee considers a dog to be aggressive then that dog must wear a muzzle while at the training ground.

Training Tip

TRAINING NEWS AND TIPS

When using food to train your dog, don't tease the dog by withholding the food too long. When your dog does the right thing, then give the food straight away and in saying that do not give the treats willy nilly.

Teach your dog to sit and wait before letting it out the front door of the house and out of the car. Do this on lead and do not make your dog wait too long before you let the dog out. Build up to longer waiting times.

When taking your dog to the park don't let it off lead if it won't come back, use a longer lead so you have control when dog takes off after another dog. You always have to be in the position to direct the dog to the right behavior, which is come when called. If the dog is off lead you can't do that.

Don't forget to do some training during the week not just on Sunday, but don't bore your dog with too many commands, pick one exercise a night that you have learnt at school. Wen you come home from work to practice that one exercise. Also don't use sentences like fetch the ball. Just say fetch.

Don't forget to always have your dog's attention when teaching any exercise. Remember training is all about fun for you and the dog, repartition and patience.

Never give up training your dog, you can do it.

Vaccinations

Don't forget to have your dog vaccinated when the time comes around, to safe guard your dog while out and about, it is one of the requirements of the dog school so as soon as you have revaccinated your dog please show the vaccination card to your instructor.

To all Dog Owners

Please don't forget to carry something to pick up the poo when walking your dog. This is required by law. You are responsible for what your dog leaves behind and fines can be hefty if you are caught not cleaning up the mess.

Just a gentle reminder:

Please sign in the folder with your class coloured dot so we know who is working on our ground of a Sunday, for Insurance purposes in case you or your dog gets hurt. Also please wear your name tag.

Coloured Flags for each class:

Once you have signed in please go to your class coloured flag, this will make it much easier for you and the Instructors and you will then also have more time to train your dog.

Training Equipment:

All you need to train the dog is a normal soft collar & a 750 mm length lead made from webbing, (you can get a nice soft collar & lead from the pet shops). Just make sure the collar is tight enough so as not to slip off over the dogs head.

Don't forget to bring treats small and soft enough to treat the dog quickly for the correct behavior.

Not all harnesses are suitable for training dogs because the dogs tend to pull and walk out in front of the handler instead of heeling beside your left leg. To get the dog to obey you; you need to have them close to your left leg so you can treat the good behavior straight away.

Liver Snacks (Dog)

Set oven at 150 degrees Celsius before you start. You will need a really sharp knife.

Ingredients: Finely prepared even fresh liver strips. The liver is not soaked. Granulated Garlic

Equipment: One sharp knife.

Oven trays greased with canola food spray. Method: Prepare liver into strips. Sprinkle with granulated garlic sparingly

Place on prepared oven tray. Spray again.

Put into oven.

Turn occasionally – when the liver is dry and hard remove from oven.

Allow to cool and store refrigerated in an airtight container.

Should keep for 3 weeks.

Doggie Treats (Makes 2 dozen treats)

Ingredients: 1 ½ cups Wholemeal wheat flour, ½ cup Wheat germ, ½ cup Melted bacon fat, 1 Large egg, ½ cup Cold water

Method: Combine all ingredients in a medium bowl and mix by hand until dough forms.

Add more flour if the dough is too sticky. Add more bacon fat or water if dough is too stiff.

Roll out onto a floured surface, to a thickness of just under 1/2 inch.

Cut into 1x4 inch bars and transfer to a cookie sheet.

Poke divots into the bars (I use a chop stick) and bake in a preheated oven for approximately 20 minutes or until lightly browned.

Turn the oven off, flip the bars, and place back in the oven until cool (this will further crisp them). Preheat the oven to 350 F.
