INTRODUCTION

Our Club was formed in 1969 to cater for those owners of purebred dogs who were interested in trailing their dogs to Obedience Trial standard and has been very successful in this regard. On being granted affiliation with the Victorian Canine Association in 1979, all breeds whether registered or not have been accepted.

CLUB RULES

- All dogs should be kept on leash at all times, excepted when given permission to work off leash in class.
- Handlers wishing to leave their dogs tied up on the Club grounds should only do so
 if their dogs are safe with people especially children. No dog may be tied up where
 it can reach another dog.
- Dogs in season should not come down to training for four weeks. This does not mean you should stop the training of your dog.
- Dogs must be immunized against distemper and canine hepatitis before coming to classes. This should also be renewed yearly.
- A dog suffering from any illness or skin problems should not be brought to classes until a Vet has pronounced the condition not contagious.
- Handler must remove their dog's excreta from the training area implements are provided.
- Physical punishment of dogs is not permitted in training classes.

- Instructors have authority over their classes and may ask a member to take their dog out of class if it is disruptive.
- Instructors are not permitted to handle and train a member's dog in class.
- While at the grounds before and after classes please control your dogs, also hitting of other people's dogs are not allowed.
- If Committee considers a dog to be aggressive then that dog must wear a muzzle while at the training ground.

AROUND THE OBEDIENCE & TRACKING EVENTS 2019

Hastings Obedience Dog Club on 15th of June Brian Arter & Kadnook Westburys Hot Design entered two trials on the one day and gained two passes one was a qualifying score of 173 points, the other was a qualifying score of 183 points and 1st place with both passes. Not only did Brian & Flick gain these passes on the one day it gave them their CDX title (Community Dog Excellent).

On the 22nd, 23rd, 24th of June we ran our Tracking Trial up at Coldstream and Rhonda Cheesman & Belcroft Believe In Diamonds (Meka) entered the trial and gain two passes towards their TD (Tracking Dog Title) Meka had to follow Rogers footsteps for 400 metres with 2 turns find Rogers socks on the way and also find him for the first pass which Rhonda & Meek gained was a Qualifying score of Excellent. for the other pass Rhonda & Meka had to do the same again but this time the length of the track was 800 metres with a qualifying score of Very Good one more test to go for the title.

Keith Byrne & Torquela Trillian Astra (Trillian) at the Dalmatian Club of Victoria on the 8th of June gained their (ET) Endurance title.

Keith & Elfking Big Boss (Zaphod) went to the German Shepherd Dog Club on the 22nd of June and gained their (ET) Endurance title.

Keith & Zaphod have been doing really well gaining 2 passes with Saluki Club of Victoria on 6th of July & the 7th of July 1st qualifying score of 177 points the 2nd pass with a qualifying score of 165 points this gave Keith & Zaphod their Junior Lure Course (JC) Title.

Also Congratulations to Keith & Ch Elfking Big Boss (Zaphod) for gaining his Show Title.

Melissa Murdock & Ch Zareine Secret Kiss (Gypsy) entered the Wangaratta double trial this year and gained a pass towards their Companion Dog Title (CD) with a qualifying score of 183 and 3rd place.

Melissa & Gypsy after a little more training at Wangaratta set of for the Albury Trials on Saturday after a bit of bribery that she would never have to do it again Gypsy gained two passes in CD with qualifying scores of 1st pass 190 points 2nd pass 185 points this gave Melissa & Gypsy their Companion Dog Title. On the Sunday entered the Rally trial in Rally Advance class and gained two passes after having another bribe of ice-cream this time1st pass 93 points 2nd pass 92 points one more pass to gain their Rally Advance Title (RA).

TRAINING NEWS AND TIPS

Training Tip

Training is all about patience kindness as well as giving the dog some direction on how to behave in the house and while out walking, dogs do not understand us they learn only by reparation and this will not be learnt over night. So when your dog sit, stands, or drops on their own tell them they are good dogs as well as the word relating to that action. There are lots of ways to train your dog and the Instructors try very hard to help you do this but you need to play your part in achieving this, we are not training your dog we are actual helping you how to manage your dog if you are having difficulty then please ask your Instructor about your problem. When training your dog please walk normally and stand up straight do not bend over your dog all of this is showing your dog you know what you are doing, don't forget to praise and treat your dog when they do the right thing only. Don't forget to practice at home all you and your dog has learnt on Sunday, during the week as well not just on Sundays at school

Never give up training your dog, you can do it.

Vaccinations

Don't forget to have your dog vaccinated when the time comes around, to safe guard your dog while out and about, it is one of the requirements of the dog school so as soon as you have re-vaccinated your dog please show the vaccination card to your instructor. <u>To all Dog Owners</u>

Please don't forget to carry something to pick up the poo when walking your dog. This is required by law. You are responsible for what your dog leaves behind and fines can be hefty if you are caught not cleaning up the mess.
