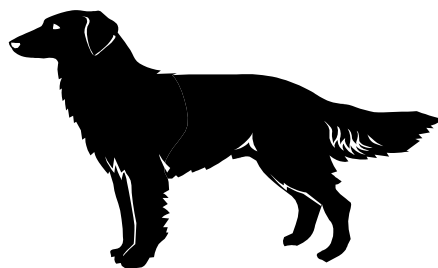

INTRODUCTION

Our Club was formed in 1969 to cater for those owners of purebred dogs who were interested in trailing their dogs to Obedience Trial standard and has been very successful in this regard. On being granted affiliation with the Victorian Canine Association in 1979, all breeds whether registered or not have been accepted.

CLUB RULES

- **All dogs should be kept on leash at all times, excepted when given permission to work off leash in class.**
- Handlers wishing to leave their dogs tied up on the Club grounds should only do so if their dogs are safe with people especially children. No dog may be tied up where it can reach another dog.
- Dogs in season should not come down to training for four weeks. This does not mean you should stop the training of your dog.
- Dogs must be immunized against distemper and canine hepatitis before coming to classes. This should also be renewed yearly.
- A dog suffering from any illness or skin problems should not be brought to classes until a Vet has pronounced the condition not contagious.
- Handler must remove their dog's excreta from the training area – implements are provided.
- Physical punishment of dogs is not permitted in training classes.
- Instructors have authority over their classes and may ask a member to take their dog out of class if it is disruptive.
- Instructors are not permitted to handle and train a member's dog in class.

- **While at the grounds before and after classes please control your dogs, also hitting of other peoples dogs are not allowed.**
- **If Committee considers a dog to be aggressive then that dog must wear a muzzle while at the training ground.**

AROUND THE OBEDIENCE & TRACKING EVENTS 2015

Southern Obedience Dog Club 14-3-15 Yuki Kamo and Keanstar Grand Impression (Aska) gained their first pass towards Rally Novice with a qualifying score of 95 points. Yuki & Aska entered Dogs Victoria Easter trials on 4-4-15 & 5-4-15 1st trial gained a qualifying score of 92 points, 2nd trial gained a qualifying score of 91 points this gave Yuki and Aska their Rally Novice Title.

Yuki & Aska also went to a couple of tracking trials and gained more titles, first was the Golden Retriever club of Victoria 23-5-15 gained a qualifying score of good towards their Tracking Champion Title, the other pass was with the Tracking Club of Victoria on the 11-7-15 and gained a qualifying score of pass this gave Yuki & Aska their Tracking Champion Title

Also at same tracking trials Golden Retriever Club 25-5-15 Andrea Sciberras & Carlandy Ronin (Ronan) gained a qualifying score of good to pass their test 7, the went to the Tracking Club Trial 13-7-15 & gained their last pass with a qualifying score of pass to gain their Tracking Champion Title.

Margo Hone & Fernfall Rainbow Connection (Darby) entered the Weimaraner Club of Victoria 19-4-15 in CCD for the 1st time and passed with a qualifying score of 87 points & 3rd place.

TRAINING NEWS AND TIPS

Training Tip

Training is all about patience kindness as well as giving the dog some direction on how to behave in the house and while out walking, dogs do not understand us they learn only by reparation and this will not be learnt over night. So when your dog sit, stands, or drops on their own tell them they are good dogs as well as the word relating to that action. There are lots of ways to train your dog and the Instructors try very hard to help you do this but you need to play your part in achieving this, we are not training your dog we are actual helping you how to manage your dog if you are having difficulty then please ask your Instructor about your problem. When training your dog please walk normally and stand up straight do not bend over your dog all of this is showing your dog you know what you are doing, don't forget to praise and treat your dog when they do the right thing only. Don't forget to practice at home all you and your dog has learnt on Sunday, during the week as well not just on Sundays at school.

Never give up training your dog, you can do it.

Vaccinations

Don't forget to have your dog vaccinated when the time comes around, to safe guard your dog while out and about, it is one of the requirements of the dog school so as soon as you have re-vaccinated your dog please show the vaccination card to your instructor.

To all Dog Owners

Please don't forget to carry something to pick up the poo when walking your dog. This is required by law. You are responsible for what your dog leaves behind and fines can be hefty if you are caught not cleaning up the mess.
