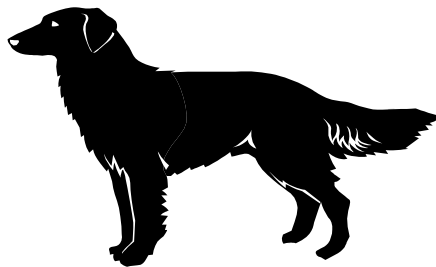

INTRODUCTION

Our Club was formed in 1969 to cater for those owners of purebred dogs who were interested in trailing their dogs to Obedience Trial standard and has been very successful in this regard. On being granted affiliation with the Victorian Canine Association in 1979, all breeds whether registered or not have been accepted.

CLUB RULES

- **All dogs should be kept on leash at all times, excepted when given permission to work off leash in class.**
- Handlers wishing to leave their dogs tied up on the Club grounds should only do so if their dogs are safe with people especially children. No dog may be tied up where it can reach another dog.
- Dogs in season should not come down to training for four weeks. This does not mean you should stop the training of your dog.
- Dogs must be immunised against distemper and canine hepatitis before coming to classes. This should also be renewed yearly, and sighted again after being renewed.
- A dog suffering from any illness or skin problems should not be brought to classes until a Vet has pronounced the condition not contagious.
- Handler must remove their dog's excreta from the training area – implements are provided.
- Physical punishment of dogs is not permitted in training classes.
- Instructors have authority over their classes and may ask a member to take their dog out of class if it is disruptive.
- Instructors are not permitted to handle and train a member's dog in class.
- While at the grounds before and after classes please control your dogs.

- Hitting of other people's dogs is not allowed.
- If Committee considers a dog to be aggressive then that dog must wear a muzzle while at the training ground

TRAINING NEWS AND TIPS

Training Tip

Training tip this newsletter is about what's on in your class just look on the flag if you haven't been given a flyer as yet.

The COLOURED DOT on your name tag is the class you are in so PLEASE just sign in, in that colour folder when you arrive at the Club then please move away so other people can sign on thanks. Please wear your name tag, if you have lost it ask for another one just a suggestion put the name tag in your glove box and you won't lose it.

New members Starting at 9.30 am: Please sign the PINK folder until you are promoted to the next class.

Next class: Starting at 9.30 am: Please sign in the PURPLE folder until you are promoted to the next class.

Next class: Starting at 9.30 am Please sign in the BLUE folder until you are promoted to the next class.

Next class: Starting at 9.00 am Please sign in the GREEN folder until you are promoted to the next class

Next class: Starting at 9.00 am Please sign in the RED folder, this class is not the trailing class.

Trialing class: Starting at 10.15 am this class is for members that wish to trial their dogs to an Obedience or Rally Title, if you wish to join this class then please sign in the week before in the BLACK folder bearing in mind this class is only for Instructors and people wishing to enter trials. Our Ground hire for Simpson Park Obedience Training is from 9.00 am until 12.00 pm.

HAPPY INSTRUCTORS = MAKE GOOD CLASSES

All our Instructors are Volunteers who help out so your Dog is trained. They all give their time freely, every week.

PLEASE REMEMBER:

They are all doing their best to help you and a smile goes a long way. 😊

They want to help you train your dog. If you are having trouble please ask for help.

Make yourself more interesting to be with and your dog will walk nicely beside you. Occasionally recall your dog to you on the walk this is teaching your dog to come when called, do not forget to reward the dog for the behavior you want.

Dogs name is not a command it is only to get the dogs attention, you need to follow up with whatever you want the dog to do, i.e. sit, stand, drop, stay, down or come. Spend a couple of minutes each day to teach your dog what you have learnt each week at school; it doesn't work expecting your dog to know what you want just on training days above all have fun with your dog.

We never give up training you & your dog; we believe you can do it.

Vaccinations

Don't forget to have your dog vaccinated when the time comes around, to safe guard your dog while out and about, it is one of the requirements of the dog school so as soon as you have re-vaccinated your dog please show the vaccination card to your instructor.

To all Dog Owners

Please don't forget to carry something to pick up the poo when walking your dog. This is required by law. You are responsible for what your dog leaves behind and fines can be hefty if you are caught not cleaning up the mess.
