

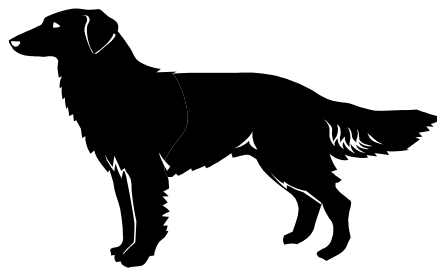

INTRODUCTION

Our Club was formed in 1969 to cater for those owners of purebred dogs who were interested in trailing their dogs to Obedience Trial standard and has been very successful in this regard. On being granted affiliation with the Victorian Canine Association in 1979, all breeds whether registered or not have been accepted.

CLUB RULES

Classes Start at 9.00 am for members in the Red & Green classes.
9.30 am for members in the Pink, Purple & Blue classes.

Please sign in your respective folder before going into class

- **While at the Club. All dogs should be kept on leash at all times, excepted when given permission to work off leash in class.**
- Handlers wishing to leave their dogs tied up on the Club grounds should only do so if their dogs are safe with people especially children. No dog may be tied up where it can reach another dog.
- Dogs in season should not come down to training for four weeks. This does not mean you should stop the training of your dog.
- Dogs must be immunized against distemper and canine hepatitis before coming to classes. This should also be renewed yearly.
- A dog suffering from any illness or skin problems should not be brought to classes until a Vet has pronounced the condition not contagious.
- Handler must remove their dog's excreta from the training area – implements are provided.
- Physical punishment of dogs is not permitted in training classes.
- Instructors have authority over their classes and may ask a member to take their dog out of class if it is disruptive.
- Instructors are not permitted to handle and train a member's dog in class.

- **While at the grounds before during and after classes please control your dogs, also hitting of other people's dogs are not allowed. (Please Do Not let your dog go to another dog while in class unless the Instructor & Handler has said otherwise.) If Committee consider a dog to be aggressive then that dog must wear a muzzle while at the training ground**

Croydon & District Obedience Dog Club on the 31st March Briar & Icebear (Bear) entered the Rally trials and gained two passes on the day, one in the morning with a qualifying score of 91 points & 2nd place this gave Bear & Briar their Master Title, in the afternoon just to show it was no fluke Bear & Briar qualified with a score of 92 points

Hungarian Vizsla Club on the 4th May Brian Arter & Kadnook Westburys Design and (Flick) gained their first pass towards their Open Title (Companion Dog Excellent) with a qualifying score of 185 points & 1st place.

DOGS BIRTHDAY CAKE

- 500 grams Lamb minced or Beef or Rabbit, Etc
- 500 grams Chicken mince
- 1-2 cloves Garlic grated
- 1 Carrot grated
- 1 Zucchini grated
- 2-4 Flowers Broccoli chopped or grated
- 2-4 Flower Collie flower chopped or grated
- 1/2 Stick Celery chopped or grated
- 1/2 cup cooked Rice
- 2 tablespoons Processed Bran
- 6 Eggs

Spices

- 1 teaspoon Italian mix
- 1 teaspoon Basil
- 1 teaspoon powdered Ginger

Mix altogether put into a microwave loaf dish and cook for 10-15 minutes, may take a little longer in some microwaves, or make small hamburgers of the mixture these take less time to cook about 10 minutes in the microwave.

TRAINING NEWS AND TIPS

Training Tip

When using food to train your dog don't tease the dog by withholding the food too long, when you're dog dose the right thing you want them to do then give the food straight away, and in saying that do not give the treats willy nilly.

Teach your dog to sit and wait before letting it out the front door, and out of the car, do this on lead do not make your dog wait too long before you let the dog out. Build up to longer waiting times.

When taking your dog to the park don't let it of lead if it won't come back, use a longer lead so you have control when dog takes off after another dog, you always have to be in the position to direct the dog to the right behavior which is come when called and if the dog is off lead you can't do that.

Don't forget to do some training during the week not just on Sunday, but don't bore your dog with too many commands, pick one exercise a night that you have learnt at school when you come home from work to practice. Also don't use sentences like fetch the ball. Just say fetch.

Don't forget to always have your dog's attention when teaching any exercise.

Remember training is all about fun for you and the dog, repartition and patience.

Never give up training your dog, you can do it.

Vaccinations

Don't forget to have your dog vaccinated when the time comes around, to safe guard your dog while out and about, it is one of the requirements of the dog school so as soon as you have re-vaccinated your dog please show the vaccination card to your instructor.

To all Dog Owners

Please don't forget to carry something to pick up the poo when walking your dog. This is required by law. You are responsible for what your dog leaves behind and fines can be hefty if you are caught not cleaning up the mess.
